

Home Learning for Year 2 - Autumn Term 1

On the 'Topic Web' we have outlined our learning in different subjects for this half term. The grid below contains nine different activities that your child can complete at home over the course of this half term to support their learning at school. Much of it is based around the theme of our topics: 'All about me' and 'Not all superheroes wear capes'. We would like your child to try and complete a minimum of one line of three home-learning activities by the end of the half term. The line can be horizontal, vertical or diagonal but must pass through the centre square. Please send in completed homework with communication books so we can see it and celebrate it in class.

Art- Create your own artwork trying to copy a famous artist of your choice such as Van Gough, Frida Kahlo or Picasso. How creative can you be?	History - Talk with your family about all the things that have happened to you in your life. Can you remember them in the right order?	Writing- Write a short fact file about something you know a lot about. It could be about the beach, Minecraft or anything else!
Science - Look around your garden or the park. How many different habitats can you find where different animals might live? Can you make a labelled drawing of what you found?	Non-negotiable task - Read with an adult at least 3 times a week - or even better, every day!	Geography - Learn the names of the continents and the oceans - can you find a song on Youtube that you could learn?
PE - How many different shapes can you make with your body? Can you make letters to spell out words?	Computing- Can you create digital art on an iPad or laptop? If you do not have a computer at home, we can organise for you to use one at lunchtime at school.	Maths - How many calculations can you work out that equal 10? Or, if you want a challenge, how many can you work out that equal 20 or 50?

Maths and English

In English we are going to be working on spelling our Common Exception Words. We will be learning about the different ways we can use capital letters, structuring a story and a letter. In this half term we will also be looking at conjunctions and how they help us.

In Maths we will be learning all about how to add and subtract numbers as well as continuing to understand Place Value e.g. how many Tens and Ones are in a number.



Useful 5 minute Time Filler Activities Linked to Year Two End of Year Expectations

- Read a book or magazine.
- Say/write the days of the week and months of the year
- Practise telling the time to the nearest hour and half hour
- Go for an autumnal walk- look at the trees, how are they changing?
- Talk about how the seasons change from Autumn to Winter.
