

SEESAW - AN ONLINE LEARNING JOURNAL

Seesaw is a secure online learning journal where students can document their learning in school. Staff will be able to add observations, photos and videos of your child's learning. Your child will also learn to add their own responses (including photos, videos, drawings and voice recordings) to their Seesaw journal. Seesaw is used from Year R – Year 2.

Your child will be able to sign into the Seesaw account at home, allowing them to upload their home learning and to enable you to see the learning that has been happening at school. You will also be able to comment on your child's work throughout the school year.

In order for your child to use Seesaw, the app needs your child's name in order to be able to associate work like their photos, videos or voice recordings with their account. Seesaw only uses this information to provide the service and doesn't advertise in Seesaw, create profiles of students, or share or sell your child's personal information or journal content.
