Be a positive role model, encourage my/our child to abide by our School Behaviour Policy, take responsibility for their actions and treat people and property with respect.

Keep the school informed promptly of any matters which affect my/our child, including any period of absence.

Encourage my/our child to lead an active healthy lifestyle.

Use social media responsibly to ensure I/we do not breach school safeguarding, data protection and complaints guidance when posting pictures of children during school activities or make inappropriate comments that will appear online.

Provide an excellent curriculum, providing for problem solving, challenging and supporting where necessary, to equip them for a changing technological future.

Provide a stimulating learning environment and facilities which will foster their development and encourage their individuality.

Assist his/her moral and spiritual development through rewarding good work, good behaviour and ensuring opportunities to explore thoughts, beliefs and feelings, showing respect and consideration for others.

Inform you regularly about your child's progress and arrange curriculum specific information sessions.

Teach your child the school's values and reward system to take responsibility for their actions and show respect for others.

Teach your child about health, exercise and nutrition and help them make the right choices.
